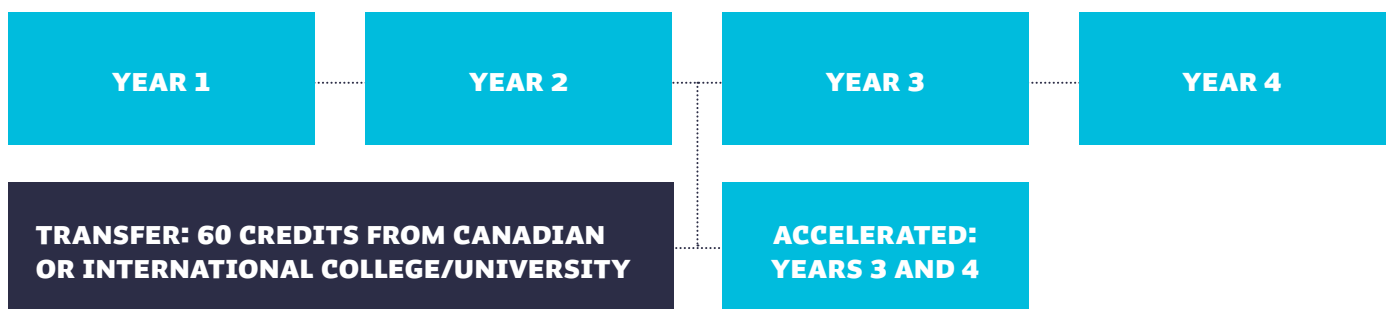

ENTRANCE AND IN-COURSE AWARDS
